EMERGENCY ADOPTION & NOTICE MEMO

Date: February 14, 2022

To: Board Members

RE: Amend IAC 282 Chapter 24

This is an emergency adoption of the following rule change that will go into effect immediately. A second noticed rule will also be filed. This noticed rule will go through the process and take over the emergency rule when done.

This amendment will allow the executive director to grant permission to schools to allow paraeducators who hold the substitute authorization as an area of concentration to substitute outside of their assigned special education classroom.

24.4(9) Paraeducator substitute authorization. An individual who holds a paraeducator certificate and completes the substitute authorization requirements set forth in rule 282—22.2(272) but who does not meet the degree requirement in subparagraph 22.2(1)“a”(2) is authorized to substitute only in the special education classroom in which the individual paraeducator is employed-, unless emergency permission is granted by the executive director or designee based on documented need provided by the employer.
